
The Tomato Timer add-on is an add-on for Citavi 6.2 or later created by Citavi user Daniel Lutz. It inserts a tomato-shaped button at the bottom-right of Citavi which tells users when to focus and when to take breaks.



Work/break cycle

- 25 min. work
- 5 min. break
- 25 min. work
- 5 min. break
- 25 min. work
- 15 min. break

Since the tomato timer add-on is an external add-on, it requires a few extra steps to be installed. Please follow the steps below or wait until the add-on is available directly in Citavi.

- 1. Exit Citavi.
- 2. Download the zip file from this link.
- 3. Save the file on your computer, right-click it, and select Extract all.
- 4. In Windows Explorer switch to the folder *C:\Program Files (x86)\Citavi 6* and create a new folder named "AddOns" if it is not there already.
- 5. Copy the files to the *AddOns* folder.
- 6. Start Citavi.

A tomato button will appear at the bottom-right of your screen.
